

**MINUTES OF THE 441<sup>st</sup> REGISTRATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 05.09.2022 and in continuation on 14.09.2022.**

The 441<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Registration Committee (RC) was held under the Chairmanship of Dr. A. K. Singh, Chairman, Registration Committee on 05.09.2022 at 17:00 Hrs onwards and in continuation on 14.09.2022 through NIC video conference. Dr. J. P. Singh, PPA, DPPQ&S, Faridabad; Dr. S. C. Dubey, ADG (PP&B) ICAR, KrishiBhawan, New Delhi; Dr. S. P. Sahni (Representative of Drug Controller General of India) New Delhi; Dr. Vishal Chaudhary, Deputy Industrial Advisor, Ministry of Chemical and Petrochemical, New Delhi and Dr. Sanjay Arya, APPA & Secretary, CIB&RC attended the meeting. Dr. J.P Singh, PPA took the opportunity to introduce the newly appointed Dr. Sanjay Arya as APPA & Secretary (CIB&RC). At the outset, Chairman welcomed the members and asked Secretary, CIB&RC to take up the agenda for deliberations. The decisions taken by the RC are as under:-

<b>1.0</b>	<b>Follow up action on Agenda Item No. 10.2 of 440<sup>th</sup> RC meeting in view of direction of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed by the order dated 01.06.2022 and 03.08.2022 in WP No. 1987 &amp; 1988 of 2022 filed by M/s MM Traders &amp; M/s MV Traders vs UOI &amp; others.</b>
	RC perused the agenda and observed that the Secretariat of CIB&RC has scrutinized the applications submitted by the petitioner/applicant and deficiencies were observed from Chemistry, Toxicology, Bio-efficacy and Packaging disciplines and the same were duly communicated to petitioner by concerned experts. It is also been apprised to RC that an affidavit as to the status of the matter has been filed before the High Court of Delhi. RC advises the applicant to cure the deficiencies so that further scrutiny process carried out in compliance of the above referred order. RC also desired that the above matters may be attended by the concerned experts before the Hon'ble Delhi High Court on the scheduled hearing of the matters.

	"Minutes of agenda item No. 10.51 of the 440 <sup>th</sup> RC may be read as under:

	<p>RC perused the Report of the Sub-Committee and decided that –</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The registration of technical should be mandatory for all cases of registration of pesticides in case of Formulation import and Formulation indigenous manufacturing. The new guidelines shall be framed for the purposes.</li><li>2. The registrant should be encouraged to obtain technical registration along with formulation of FI/FIM. The existing guidelines shall be in force till the new guidelines are framed.</li><li>3. Date of implementation of the renewed policy/guidelines should be from the date as decided by the Central Government.</li></ol> <p>The RC further decided that these recommendations should be communicated to the DA&amp;FW for approval prior to implementation.</p>
