

ORDER

Whereas the Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Department of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, has received requests from pesticide associations and industries regarding providing clarification related to Gazette Notification No. 367(E) dated 03.06.2025, whereby amendments were made in the provisions of sale of household insecticides in Insecticides Rules, 1971.

And whereas, with the objective of making household insecticide products available to the general public and having given due consideration to such representations, the Central Government in exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Insecticides Act, 1968 (46 of 1968) conveys the following to the State Governments/UTs :

"According to the Gazette Notification No. 367 (E) dated 03.06.2025, there is a scope of exemption from the separate printed leaflet if a QR code mechanism, which is in full compliance with the amended provisions of Rule 18(1)(u), is used as a legally valid medium for providing the statutory information when an insecticide is intended solely for the control of cockroaches, mosquitoes, houseflies, and bed bugs."
